Visit to Angus Archives

The East and Old Church organized two events at Angus Archives on the evening of the 25th October and two sessions during the day on the 27th October.

The Archives had arranged a display of items relating to both the church and Forfar in 1791 to celebrate the original opening of the church 225 years ago.

Amongst the gems on show were the 1668 land grant for the building of the original church as well as the 1778-1793 Forfar Town Council minutes which documented the building of the church, the wall being built around the graveyard and a dispute over the seats inside the church for the Forfar Councilors.

Colourful plans showing the exterior and interior of the church in 1898 were also on show alongside items relating to the Strang Bell, graveyard, and the building of the church as well as the ministers, choir and Sunday School children from the late 1800s.

The Museum Service also

provided a number of communion tokens, collection ladle and a bell from 1707 which may have ben bought to herald in the Act of Union when Scotland became part of the United Kingdom.
